FT UNSRI holds AVoER 16 "Acceleration and Escalation of Research and Community Service Supporting Sustainable Development Goals Towards Zero Emission 2060"



The Faculty of Engineering, Sriwijaya University (FT Unsri) successfully held the AVoER 16 National Research and Community Service Seminar, with the theme "Acceleration and Escalation of Research and Community Service to Support Sustainable Development Goals Towards Zero Emission 2060". The event took place in the Ballroom of the Aryaduta Hotel Palembang on October 24, 2024.

This year's seminar received 200 papers, an increase of 64% compared to the previous year. These papers cover 169 areas of research and 31 areas of community service, with contributions from various cities in Indonesia such as Lampung, Tangerang, Jakarta, Malang and Makassar. Apart from educational institutions, papers also come from large companies such as PT. PUSRI, PT. Pertamina Hulu Rokan, and PT. PLN. It is hoped that the AVoER 16 seminar can encourage the acceleration of research and community service in order to achieve the vision of zero emissions by 2060. This event will not only be an opportunity to share knowledge, but also create solid collaboration between academics and industry practitioners.
